However, the image should be smaller in room light. We recommend max. 142 cm. This model is no longer offered by Toshiba.

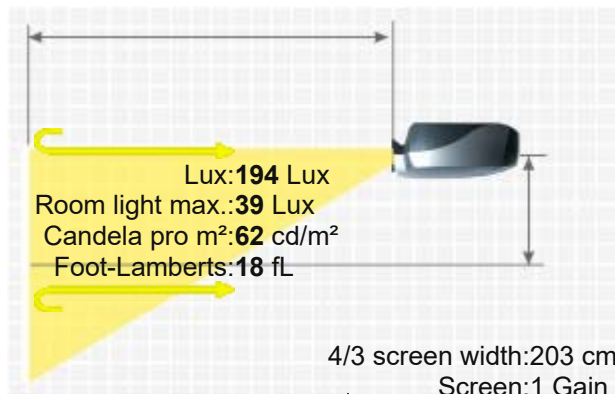
