The Toshiba model TLP T400 is an LCD projector with XGA 1024 x 768 resolution and a contrast of 400:1. The projector also offers an integrated media player with which files can be played directly. An image width of up to 348 cm is possible as the projector has 1600 Ansi lumens. However, if room light is available, the picture should be max. 232 cm wide. On the market since 2002, the model is no longer offered by the manufacturer Toshiba.

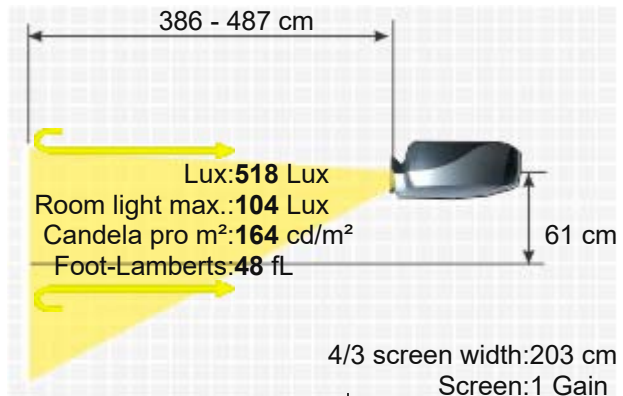
